Re: Complaint against Sam Adams for possible undue influence resulting in the loss of a signature and misuse of city resources for a political campaign

On Thursday September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2009 at approximately 12:30, I received a phone call from Rondine Ghiselline, a volunteer signature collector, who was collecting signatures at Pioneer Courthouse Square to recall Portland Mayor Sam Adams. She reported that Sam Adams approached her rebuking the recall in a way that made her feel intimidated. Ms. Ghiselline said that it appeared he was with staffers on his way to participate in an event proclaiming Portland Pancake Day.

I ask that the SOS office investigate the interaction initiated by Sam Adams toward Rondine Ghiselline to derive the following:

- 1- Did Sam Adams violate ORS 260.665 with his actions and/or the resulting loss of a signature?
- 2- Did Sam Adams use city resources or staff in an inappropriate way to participate as an opposition to the recall campaign?
